On Tuesday, November 11, 2008, from 11:00 AM until 12:00 PM EST, the DGS-COP will present a tele-gathering, 'Data Governance Principles.' Members of the Data Governance & Stewardship Community of Practice have compiled a list of guiding principles that have helped their organizations be proactive in their data-related efforts as well as a "best of" list of principles that have helped drive politics out of resolving data issues. Data Governance Institute President Gwen Thomas will present those Data Governance Principles and discusses how a principle-based governance program can help align your data stakeholders.

The discussion will focus on navigating the political landscape in an organization, and convincing stakeholders and stewards to 'get involved.'
